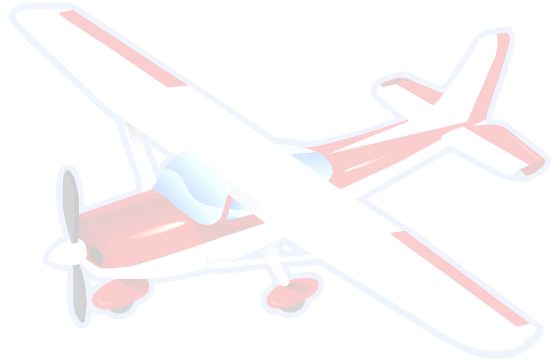

Huron County Memorial Airport located at 352 Thompson Road, one-mile South of Bad Axe. It is owned by Huron County and is overseen by the Road Commissioners. The Airport maintains 2 paved runways and hangar facilities for privately owned aircraft. An average of 6,000 aircraft uses the facility annually. General aviation accounts for 35% of use, 40% is from small business class jets, 15% from agricultural aviation and 10% of use is from freight companies' operations. In addition, Coast Guard aircraft and air rescue aircraft re-fuel at the airport rather than returning to their bases, saving time and resources.

The terminal building is open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. 7 days a week, with the exception of major holidays.

Huron County Memorial Airport is a business class airport with a 5,001-foot main runway and a 3,496-foot secondary runway. Aircraft and jet fuel are both available. It is the only airport in the Thumb providing jet service needs.
